

Adaani Frost, MD, Emeritus Professor of Medicine, Houston Methodist Hospital Institute for Academic Medicine, and HMM Research Institute.

A graduate in the first class of the new Medical school at Memorial University, St. John's Newfoundland, Dr. Adaani E. Frost trained in Internal Medicine at the Toronto General Hospital and University of Alberta, in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at the University of Toronto Hospital and McGill University and in Lung Transplantation at the Toronto Hospital System, Toronto, Canada. After completing her training Dr. Frost was recruited as Medical Director of the Lung Transplant Program at the Baylor College of Medicine affiliated hospitals, in particular Houston Methodist Hospital, a position she held until 2004. Since then Dr. Frost has focused her clinical and investigative efforts on the field of end stage lung disease, particularly pulmonary hypertension where she has participated in and played key roles in numerous clinical trials advancing the therapy of this group of disorders. In 2015, Dr. Frost then professor of Medicine at Baylor College of Medicine, joined the faculty of Houston Methodist Hospital where she established and became the first Director of the Hospital's Lung Center, Professor of Medicine at Weill Cornell Medical College and the Institute for Academic Medicine at Houston Methodist Hospital. She is now Emeritus Professor of Medicine at the Institute of Academic Medicine and the Houston Methodist Hospital Research Institute.
