

Yuichi Tamura is Associate Professor of Department of Cardiology in International University of Health and Welfare University School of Medicine, Narita, Japan. He is the director of pulmonary hypertension center in International University of Health and Welfare Mita Hospital, Tokyo, Japan. Dr. Tamura completed his medical training at Keio University, Tokyo, Japan and his residency as a fellow of pediatrics at the Mitsui Memorial Hospital, Tokyo. Prior to his current position, he was assistant professor in the Advanced Pulmonary Hypertension Treatment Department at Keio University School of Medicine and senior lecturer at the Department of Cardiology, International University of Health and Welfare.
